Rates:

Standard rate: Boarding only R125.00 per dog, per day
Rate including two meals** per day
• R150.00 (small breed) / R155.00 (medium – large breed) per dog, per day**

Peak Season rate: 1st December – 15th January 2026
Boarding only R150.00 per dog, per day
Including two meals per day R175.00 (small breed) /
R180.00 (medium – large breed)

Please be aware that different rates apply for Standard and Peak seasons. Rates are charged per day, per pet. Rates are subject to change without notice (All prices are VAT inclusive).

Our kennels use MERA Petfood, a high premium food imported from Germany at a cost of R25.00 per meal (small breed) and R30.00 per meal (medium – large breed).

Our rates are per day, providing that dogs are collected by 07h30 (weekdays) / 08h30 (weekends) - there will be no charge for that specific day. You will be charged for an extra day's stay if this time is not met.

Cancellation policy:

- 2 Weeks or more before admission – we will refund 100% of moneys paid less the non-refundable deposit.
- 1 to 2 Weeks before admission – we will refund 50% less the non-refundable deposit.
- Less than one week before admission – no refunds will be made.



Vaccination requirements for Kenneling at Four Paws Boarding Kennels



- ❖ ALL vaccinations are to be administered by a **SAVC (South African Veterinary Council member – veterinarian, vet nurse or AHT)** and proof thereof (copies of vaccination booklet) must be submitted before we will allow your dog onto our premises!
- ❖ **Annual 5-in-1, Rabies and KENNEL COUGH vaccinations** up to date and cover the boarding period and preferably not within two weeks before arrival date.
- ❖ Please note that the KENNEL COUGH vaccination is not included in the standard annual vaccinations and must be specifically requested at the vet.
- ❖ Please see below our policy regarding Kennel Cough.
- ❖ **Accommodation will be refused if incorrectly vaccinated.**

KENNEL COUGH

Kennel cough is an infectious disease that affects the upper respiratory tract of dogs. It leads to a dry, hacking cough which sounds as if something is stuck in the dog's throat.

Similar to the way that the common cold in humans doesn't have a single viral or bacterial cause, kennel cough is caused by a group of mostly viruses and often a bacteria called Bordetella bronchiseptica.

An uncomplicated kennel cough lasts for about a week or two. The dog has frequent fits of coughing but is otherwise active and normal. Uncomplicated cases do not involve fever or listlessness, merely a lot of coughing.

Injectable Pneumodog Vaccine: The primary vaccination – two injections two to three weeks apart, thereafter, once yearly. The vaccination should be given at least a week before introducing your dog to a group of other dogs.

Intranasal KC Vaccine: The primary vaccination – a once-off vaccination which is effective within three days. Annual revaccination is also required as with the injectable vaccine. This injection is slightly more expensive but advisable should you need a last-minute vaccination for kennel purposes.

MAP

Travel approx 15km on N2 from Beacon Bay towards Umtata and take 2nd Brakfontein turnoff to the left (this 5.1km after the Gonubie Farmers' Hall turnoff which is the 1st Brakfontein (R102) turnoff that you can take too). At this 2nd Brakfontein turnoff, which is a crossroads, you will turn LEFT. You will travel approx. 70m, going over a cattle grid, and take the first left. Again take first left after approx 100m onto dirt road. Signposted to Four Paws Dog Training Club. Go **under bridge (N2)**, follow dirt road. We are first farm on the right after 800m.
